The Syracuse Elfun Chapter executive Committee is in the process of incorporating the Syracuse Elfun Society as an IRS 501(C)7 social club and will obtain our own liability insurance for our standalone activities. Corporate Elfun has provided funding to pay for this process. We have hired a preparing lawyer who is the necessary documentation to establish our new corporation with the goal of certification by New York State prior to December 31, 2014. Future Community Service projects will be done as GE Volunteers for liability insurance coverage. We are working to establish our own web site that will be very similar in structure to that provided by Corporate Elfun.
